**Services Defined:**

**Surrender:** an "owned" animal is turned-over and given permanently to the shelter or organization. May include a fee.

**Sick/Injured Stray:** Provides care for stray / "un-owned" sick/injured cats, dogs and other pet-type animals (at no charge).

**TNR:** "Trap-Neuter-Return". A program to sterilize outside living ("un-owned") feral / stray cats.

**Animal Control:** Government departments that handle things such as: stray animals; sick, injured, or dead animals (sometimes including wildlife); aggressive animals; animal bites; animal cruelty or neglect; animals in distress; and animal related municipal code violations.
