FREE SPAY/NEUTER for FERALS!

Feral Freedom Program

All Feral Freedom programs require the trapper to surrender the cat/kitten to the shelter. Kittens under 4 months may not qualify. Cats will be neutered, microchipped, treated for fleas, vaccinated, and ear tipped then returned by volunteers to the address listed.
